Looking ahead:

READING/ELA

Right now, we are reviewing all the parts of speech. We have talked about subjects and predicates, complete sentences. vs. sentence fragments, capitalization, and punctuation. We are also starting our writing workshop to prepare for our writing.

MATH

In math, 3rd grade is working on place value and comparing whole numbers, and 4th grade is working on place value and writing numbers in standard, expanded, and word form. We are also working on skip counting as a whole group to help build fluency for multiplication.

SCIENCE/SOCIAL STUDIES

In science, we are learning about motion and energy. The students are learning how energy is transferred and what makes things move. They are working on a project where they have to create an obstacle out of paper and tape to see who can make the ping-pong ball take the longest to get through it. In Social Studies, we will be starting our unit on how laws are made and changed within the state, and the major purposes of the Missouri Constitution.
